

# **SUCRAL**

## Features:

- Perennial ryegrass
- Tetraploid

## Heading date:

- 22/05

Heading date observed in trials performed in West Central France **Profile:**

Soil types:

Sowing rate: - 25 to 30 kg/ha (10 to 12 kg/ac) as pure - or in combination with 2 to 3 kg/ha (0.8 to 1.2 kg/ac) white clover

# Improved animal performances: **ITS ADVANTAGES**

- SUCRAL as been selected to produce a forage very rich in sugars and highly digestible.
- The high sugar content of SUCRAL enhances its palatability and its ingestion and also allows a better efficiency of the consumed nitrogen and therefore an increased production of milk and meat.

## • A rustic and productive variety:

- SUCRAL is a productive variety that distinguishes itself by its ability to produce a forage in summer/fall unlike other varieties that deplete after a high growth during the spring.
- SUCRAL also has a very good health status (resistant to diseases) ensuring the production of healthy leaves in any situations.

# FOR WHAT USE ?



### Seeding (August-September or March-April):

- Prepare a thin surface soil;
- · Seed at a depth of 1 up to 2 cm;
- · Roll right after seeding.

### Protection:

- · Monitor slugs during the implantation and take action if needed;
- · Remove the weeds (as early as 3-4 leaves stage) if needed (seek advice from your technician).
