Like protein peas and broad beans, the sweet white lupin is a leguminous crops.

It is a plant with a high protein content that can be produced and valued on the farm.

The lupin is an excellent crop rotation head in rotations.

It is also a fairly low-input crop, and the use of the seed offers large agri-food and industrial market.

Within the family of white lupins, there are sweet white lupin from winter type and spring type.

Instructions for use:

• Lupins are very sensitive to active limestone and hydromorphy. Search for an airy soil

Inoculation required when pH > 6.5 or in the first year

Seed 50 to 50 seeds / m2 at a depth of 2 to 3 cm

Lupin values water supplies, however, wait for blooming of the 1st stage

Seeding time:

-North Brittany, Normandy, South Picardy: 20/02 to 15/03

- South Brittany, Pays de Loire, Centre, Poitou: 20/02 to 15/03
- South-West of France: 01/02 to end of February
- -Centre East: 05/02 to beginning of March

· Harvest:

. From the end of August/beginning of September . At 14 to 15% of humidity
