Like protein peas and broad beans, the sweet white lupin is a leguminous crops.

It is a plant with a high protein content that can be produced and valued on the farm.

The lupin is an excellent crop rotation head in rotations.

It is also a fairly low-input crop, and the use of the seed offers large agri-food and industrial market.

Within the family of white lupins, there are sweet white lupin from winter type and spring type.

Instructions for use:

- · Lupins are very sensitive to active limestone and hydromorphy.
- Search for an airy soil
- Inoculation required when pH > 6.5 or in the first year
- Seed 50 to 50 seeds / m² at a depth of 2 to 3 cm
- Lupin values water supplies, however, wait for blooming of the $1^{\,\mbox{st}}$ stage

· Harvest:

- . From the end of August/beginning of September
- . At 14 to 15% of humidity
