ARTIGUE

Characteristics:

- Annual ryegrass
- Tetraploid

Heading date:

- 20/04

Heading date recorded in official trials performed in West Central France

Profile:

- Non persistent

Persistency:

- 6 to 9 months

Soil types:

- All types

Sowing rate:

- 25- 30 kg/ha (10- 12 kg/ac) straight
- or in combination with white clover 2- 3 kg/ha (0.8- 1,2 kg/ac)

BENEFITS

• A very fast forage production ability

- ARTIGUE is an early variety that starts growing early in the spring for quick forage production;
- It shows excellent performance in the first cut (105% compared to references during its registration).
- It is therefore an excellent forage cover crop, especially between two spring crops).

• Improved feed quality:

- ARTIGUE has a very good nutritional value: 78% digestibility and a soluble sugar content of 23.5% (CÉRIENCE trials).

FOR WHAT USE ?

Grazing	Mowing
	

Sowing (August-September or March-April):

- Prepare a thin seed bed;
- Sow at a depth of 1 up to 2 cm;
- Roll right after sowing.

Protection:

- Monitor slugs during the establishment and take action if needed;
- Remove the weeds at 3-4 leaves stage if needed (seek advice from your technician).

Fertilization:

- Compensate for nutrient exports (specifically 17 kg N/t D.M; 6 kg P₂O₅/t D.M and 17 kg K₂O/t D.M), especially if soil nutrient levels are low.
- Consider the soil analysis and the manure produced by animals.
