Sowing rate:

- 20 to 25 kg/ha (8 to 10 kg/ac) straight - 12 to 15 kg/ha (4-6 kg/ac), or in combination with red clover 10 to 12 kg/ha (4 to 5 kg/ac).

Highly resistant:

- TONUSS is most resistant to common ryegrass diseases (rust: 5.6, hmelinthosporiosis: 5.9);
- It provides healthy foliage and excellent feed value.

· Easy to cultivate:

- TONUSS starts growing very early ;
- Early start in spring, late heading date.
- Excellent dry matter content for a good feed intalce.

Grazing



Sowing (August-September or March-April):

- Prepare a thin seed bed;
- Sow at a depth of 1 up to 2 cm;
- Roll right after sowing.

Protection:

- Monitor slugs during the establishment and take action if needed;
- Remove the weeds at 3-4 leaves stage if needed (seek advice from your technician) ...
