Features:

- Italian ryegras

Sowing rate:

- 20 to 25 kg/ha (8 to 10 kg/ac) straight
- 12 to 15 kg/ha (4-6 kg/ac) in combination with crimson clover or vetch

STOCKY is an Italian ryegrass variety that provides abundant and consistent forage production.

- Improved productivity on first-cut :
 - STOCKY produces dense forage with a high leaf-to-stem ratio.
 - Its productivity in the first cut is excellent and consistent whatever the climatic conditions are.

Productive regrowth with high leaf content:

- The breeding of STOCKY was oriented toward its ability to generate productive, vigorous and leaf-rich regrowth.
- The energy and protein content of the plant is concentrated in the leaves.
- Thus, STOCKY provides a high quality second cut.

Very good feed quality:

- The leaf-rich composition of STOCKY provides very palatable and digestible forage.
- The foliage of STOCKY is very healthy due to autumn and spring diseases resistance, such as rust and helminthosporiosis.

FOR WHAT USE ?

Possible	

Sowing, August-September or March-April:

- Prepare a thin seed bed;
- Sow at a depth of 1 up to 2 cm;
- Roll right after sowing.

Protection:

- Monitor slugs during the establishment and take action if needed;

- Remove the weeds as early as 3-4 leaves stage if needed (seek advice from your technician).
