#### Sowing rate:

- 25-30 kg/ha (10-12 kg/ac) straight

- · Excellent spring growth and very good annual yields:
  - TENACE is very vigorous and starts early in the spring.
  - TENACE offers a good annual yield: after each harvest, its regrowth is vigorous, leafy and very healthy.

#### FOR WHAT USE?





#### Sowing August-September or March-April:

- Prepare a thin surface soil and firm it deeply;
- Sow at a depth of 1 up to 2 cm;
- Roll right after sowing.

#### Protection:

- Monitor slugs during the establishment and take action if needed;
- Remove the weeds as early as 3-4 leaves stage if needed (seek advice from your technician).
