

FOR WHAT USE?

Mowing

Sow on a finely crumbled soil on the surface and at a depth of 1 to 2 cm;

- Monitor slugs during the establishment and take action if needed; Remove the weeds during the establishment at 3-4 leaves stage

> Packaging: Bag of 15 kg

Seeding (August-September or March-April):

if needed (seek advice from your technician).

Grazing

- Roll before sowing;

- Roll right after sowing.
