

ABERLASTING



White Clover

The first variety resulting from a cross between white clover and caucasian clover in order to combine the advantages of both species.



ABERLASTING

Characteristics:

- White clover
- Small to intermediate seed type, small to medium leaves

Profile:

- Long-lasting

Persistency:

- 4 years and over

Soil types:

- All types

Sowing rate (kg/ha):

- 3 to 4 kg/ha in combination with grasses or in mixture.

ITS ADVANTAGES

- **ABERLASTING is characterised by excellent persistency and regrowth capacity, even under conditions of intensive grazing:**
 - ABERLASTING combines a stoloniferous root system, characteristic of white clover, with a rhizomatous root system, characteristic of caucasian clover.
 - Rhizomes allow for stonger roots and therefore better resistance to trampling.
- **ABERLASTING is also more resistant to drought stress than other white clovers:**
 - Its deeper and more developed root system allows it to stay green longer and improves its persistency.
- **ABERLASTING has better cold tolerance:**
 - Crossbreeding with caucasian clover improves cold tolerance compared to varieties derived from pure white clover lines.
 - ABERLASTING can withstand temperatures as low as -20°C, whereas such temperatures destroy 70% of white clovers.

IN WHAT SITUATIONS?

Grazing	Mowing

Sowing:


- Sow from March to April or from July to September;
- Prepare soil that is compacted deep down and fine on the surface to ensure good soil/seed contact;
- Sow at a depth of 1 cm;
- Roll immediately after sowing.

Protecting seedlings:

- Watch out for slugs during planting and take action if necessary.
- Weed if necessary from the 3-4 trifoliate leaf stage.
